Public Comments: No comments

Consent Agenda: Motion to approve agenda with no corrections made by N. Strickler and seconded by P. Richardson, all voted yes.

New Business: Rob Barner who removes asbestos for Kal-trek Demolition spoke briefly and answered council's questions. Told council a new asbestos survey is needed before any work can be done by his or any. The previous survey is almost 20 years old and may no longer be accurate. After the survey Barner will be able to give the council more details about the cost of the demolition. Rob was joined by his co-workers Reg Iervolina and Pat Ferrell Jr. who arrived at 7:15. C. Wickett suggests the next step should be for VM Krizan to get some new quotes to do a new updated asbestos survey on the property. And for VM to notify the demo companies of the timing of the survey for them to be present and ask questions to the asbestos surveyors.

Motion to have VM seek out at least 3 asbestos survey quotes and act on the winning quote as soon as possible, made by N. Strickler and seconded by R. Mead Jr., all voted yes.

Motion to adjourn the meeting made by A. Elwaer and seconded by T. Stull, all voted yes.
